This briefing provides a summary of the best available evidence on strategies and interventions to reduce drug offences. It focuses on police-led approaches and includes some examples of practice in forces that fit the existing evidence of what works to reduce crime.

Forces can use this evidence briefing to inform decisions about approaches to tackle drug crime.
