We've published responses to the recommendations made in our recent super-complaint report on the police response to stalking cases.

In September 2024, the College of Policing alongside the <u>Independent Office for Police Conduct</u> (IOPC) and <u>His Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary and Fire & Rescue Services</u>
(HMICFRS) published a joint report in response to a super-complaint made by the Suzy Lamplugh Trust on behalf of the National Stalking Consortium.
